

## 2012 Southern California Inter-Club Invitational Series

Qualifying events: All open competitions hosted by Southern California Inter-Club Association member clubs between Sept 26, 2011 and September 16, 2012 (16 competitions in total). Events included are freeskating events Pre-Preliminary through Senior, Adult singles and pairs (Bronze – Gold, Masters), Pre-Juvenile through Senior Pairs, Juvenile through Senior free dance.

Adult skaters will be combined by level (no separate age divisions). Masters divisions will be Int/Nov and Jr/Sr.

Open to all skaters in freeskating, pairs and free dance events. Initial rounds only will be used for points in competitions with a final round. If short programs and freeskating are separate events, only freeskating events will qualify. In combined events, the combined result will be used. Should a skater compete in the short program but do not complete the freeskating portion of combined events, no points will be earned. Number of skaters in any event will be the number of skaters with a final placement.

Point system:

Bonus points plus number of skaters; 1 less point for each lower placement:

Example 14 skaters:

- 1 **50** + 14 = **64**
- 2 **45** + 13 = **58**
- 3 **40** + 12 = **52**
- 4 **35** + 11 = **46**
- 5 **30** + 10 = **40**
- 6 **25** + 9 = **34**
- 7 **20** + 8 = **28**
- 8 **15** + 7 = **22**
- 9 **10** + 6 = **16**
- 10 **5** + 5 = **10**
- 11 **0** + 4 = **4**
- 12 **0** + 3 = **3**
- 13 **0** + 2 = **2**
- 14 **0** + 1 = **1**

Southern California Inter-Club Championship competitors will earn 25% extra points.

Skaters who skate in different divisions during the season will not carry points from one division to another. Skaters who compete in the 2011 events after Sept 25 will earn scores and those scores will carry over to the level they compete in the 2012 season.

Singles events: Skaters shall compete in at least 3 events to qualify. Top 3 events will be considered if skater competes in more than 3 events. Top 12 skaters in each division will be invited to the series final competition. If there are ties beyond 12 skaters, all tied

skaters will be invited. If 12 skaters do not qualify, skaters with 2 events will be invited next (absolute minimum of 2 events to qualify).

Pairs and dance teams: Teams who enter at least 1 event will be invited to the final.

Initial invitations will be sent after Golden West to the top qualifiers. Skaters have until the following Thursday to respond (via EntryEeze). Skaters in competitions after Golden West (Rim of the World Open and Pasadena Open) who earn a score equal or higher than a 12<sup>th</sup> place qualifier will be invited as a 'wild card' entry. These entries will not affect the invitation to skaters previously invited.

Current standings will be posted on the Southern California Inter-Club website and updated as soon as possible after each event.

The Southern California Inter-Club Invitational Series Final will be held on September 22 & 23 at Paramount Iceland. All events will be judged IJS; there will be live scoring and a "Kiss and Cry" area for the skaters to await their results. Other special events are being planned during the competition.
